As such, Project Math10 is applying to Queen's research ethics board for permission to administer research questionnaires to the Campers and to have Math Education researchers be present to observe both the teaching and the learning experience. Should Project Math10 receive ethics approval the undersigned Parent/Guardian will be contacted for additional consent regarding the participation of the student in the research portion of the camp. All information collected for research purposes will be kept anonymous and confidential.

More specifically, the researchers plan to take notes of student-student, student-tutor, and tutor-tutor interactions, administer questionnaires that ask about the student's learning preferences and ask students questions about their work on the project. Math Education researchers may opt to use audio recording devices for the purpose for transcribing purposes.

No names or personal identifying information will be recorded and all recorded information will be kept strictly confidential.
